

Dear lessee of our tents/ pagodas and stalls

We strive to provide you with only the best material for the event.

To ensure that this remains the case in the future and to avoid unnecessary stress and costs, we kindly ask you to please read the following terms of use carefully and observe them.

Terms of use for tents/pagodas and stalls

As a lessee you are obliged to return the tents/pagodas/stalls in a clean and undamaged condition!

Please ensure that you take over the tents/pagodas/stalls in proper condition. If you notice any damage or dirt on the rented goods, please report this to the organizer immediately.

Necessary repairs and cleaning will be charged to the lessee. Please handle our tents/pagodas/stalls with care.

You must not use any advertising stickers, glue strips or other things that leave adhesive residue on the tarpaulin material. Painting, piercing, cutting, stapling, and otherwise damaging the tents/pagodas is not permitted.

Be especially careful with Eddings, lipsticks and other colourfast markers. Similarly, please do not use knives/cutter blades with which it is possible to slip.

Paint spray cans, airbrush guns and other distribution systems that work with pressure should not be used.

Foodstuffs such as wine, ketchup, mustard and other colourfast substances must not come into contact with the tarpaulins. If such stains do occur, they must be removed immediately and without leaving any residue. The use of solvents and aggressive cleaning agents is prohibited. Instead, use warm water and, in difficult cases, washing-up liquid.

Ensure that no damage occurs to the tents/pagodas due to heat and fire.

Open fires/sparks and equipment such as barbecues, ovens, radiant heaters that may damage the tents/pagodas/stalls are strictly prohibited.

Keep everything at the necessary safety distance from the floor, side walls and roof.

Do not hang heavy or dangerous objects on the roof struts.

We ask you to take care when manoeuvring around the tents/pagodas. In particular, driving over the feet of the pagodas always leads to damage.
